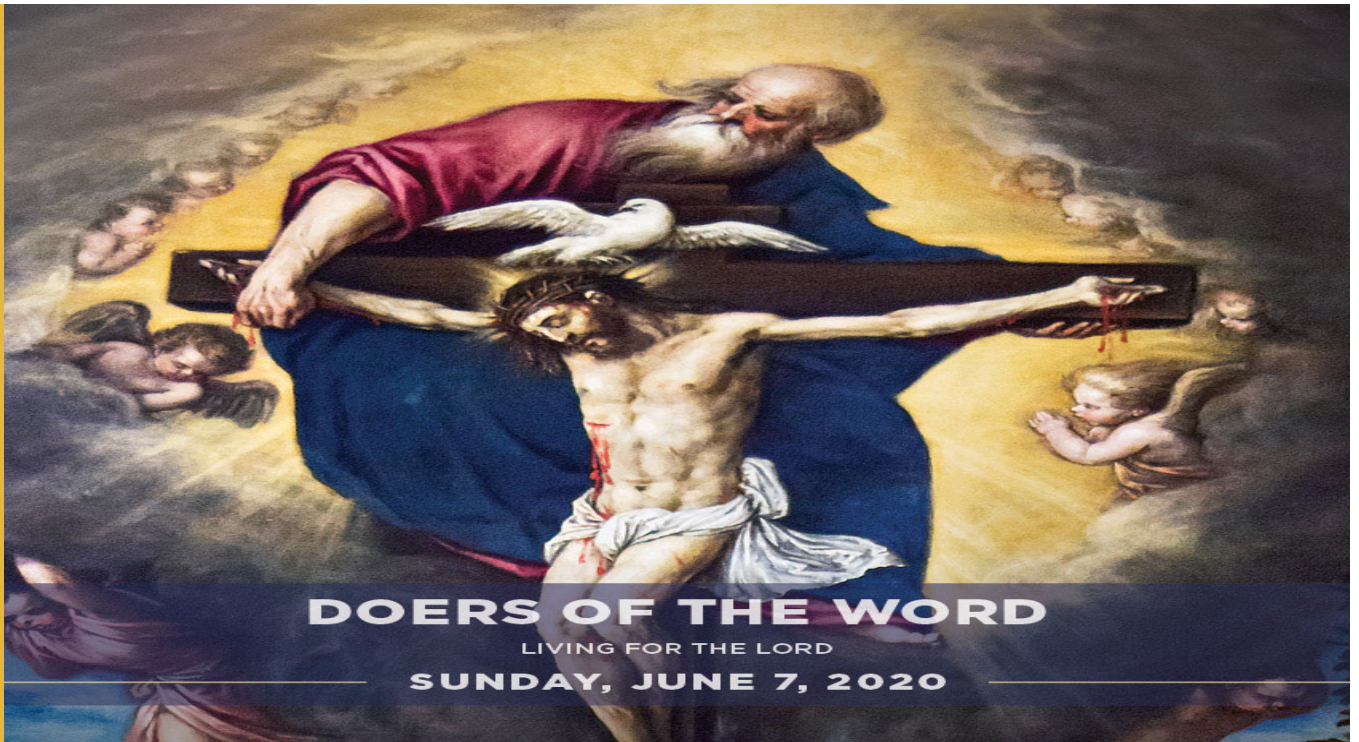

Fe, esperanza, amor; cuerpo, mente, espíritu; vida, libertad, búsqueda de la felicidad; ejecutivo, judicial, legislativo: Hay algo maravilloso, misterioso y completo en una lista de tres. Las cosas buenas vienen en tres también: desde “tocino, lechuga y tomate” hasta “Pedro, Pablo, y María.” Atento al poder del tres, las escrituras lo usan como la suma de finalización. El profeta Jonás paso tres días adentro del pescado para poder comprender completamente una lección de obediencia. Jesús resucito, sale de la tumba al tercer día. Encontramos a Dios en tres formas: como Creador, Restaurador, Santificador. Entonces, mientras afrontamos todas nuestras tribulaciones, podemos rezar: ¡Oh Dios de muchos rostros—recrea, restaura, y bendice nuestra comunidad!

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

The power in three

Faith, hope, love; body, mind, spirit; life, liberty, the pursuit of happiness; executive, judicial, legislative: There's something satisfying and complete about a list of three. Good things come in threes, too: from “bacon, lettuce, and tomato” to “Peter, Paul, and Mary.” Alert to the power of three, scripture uses it as the sum of completion. The prophet Jonah spends three days inside the fish to fully absorb a lesson in obedience. Jesus exits the tomb on the third day. We encounter God three ways: as Creator, Restorer, Sanctifier. So too, as we continue to face our trials, we can pray saying: “O God of many faces—recreate, restore, bless our community”!

TODAY'S READINGS: *Exodus 34:4b-6, 8-9; 2 Corinthians 13:11-13; John 3:16-18 (164).* “*The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.*”

QUESTIONS OF THE WEEK ? - LITURGICAL LIFE

First Reading

In Moses' appeal to the Lord to remain with the Israelites despite their sinfulness, God reveals his fidelity and mercy. Where do you see these aspects of God in your life journey?

Second Reading

We hear today one of the earliest New Testament references to the Holy Trinity in Paul's closing remarks to the Christians in Corinth. For Paul, the Trinity embodies grace, love, and fellowship. What insight does this offer us about our Triune God?

Gospel Reading

This well-known text from the Gospel of John reveals to us God's self-sacrifice for our salvation. Why do you think so many people reject or simply ignore this offer of eternal life from God?

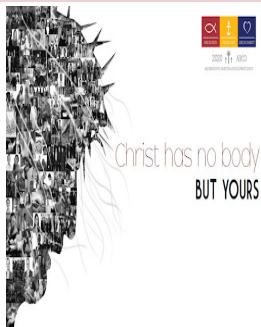

- WORSHIP AND MEDITATION -

Why do Catholics have a pope?

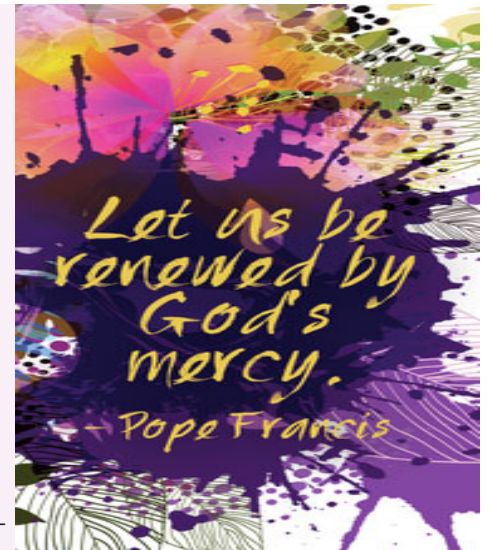
To answer the question of why Catholics have a pope, we have to pull the lens back and think about the very nature of the Church herself. According to the Nicene Creed (which is the statement of beliefs that we recite each Sunday at Mass), we profess that the Church is “one, holy, catholic, and apostolic.” These adjectives are called the marks of the Church, and they help us see that the Church is bigger than just our individual parish communities or even the Christians living in a particular region or country.

To help ensure that the community of disciples would remain united in a communion of love, Jesus entrusted the Apostles with special authority to teach, heal, and forgive sins in his name. And from among this group, Jesus chose Simon Peter to play a special role, designating him as the “rock” on which the Church was to be built (see Matthew 16:18-19; John 21:15-17). Peter “the Rock” became the visible sign of union within and among the Apostles. In time, as Peter and the other Apostles passed away, other men were chosen to take their place. The successors of St. Peter — who we honor as the first Bishop of Rome — and the successors of the other Apostles (the bishops) continued the work entrusted by Jesus to that first generation of Church leaders.

According to long-standing tradition, the successor of Peter was Linus, who was followed by Cletus, who was followed by Clement I, etc. This line of succession continues to Pope Francis in our own time.

Over the centuries, these Bishops of Rome — who came to be known as the “pope” (from papa, which means “father” in Latin) — still continue to act as the “rock” of the Church and as the visible sign of unity for all the Catholic Christians. The pope, more than any other bishop, stands as the Church’s primary teacher and as pastor of the Church throughout the world, helping to ensure that the Church remains what Jesus intended her to be: one, holy, catholic, and apostolic.

Dear Parishioner of Saint James,

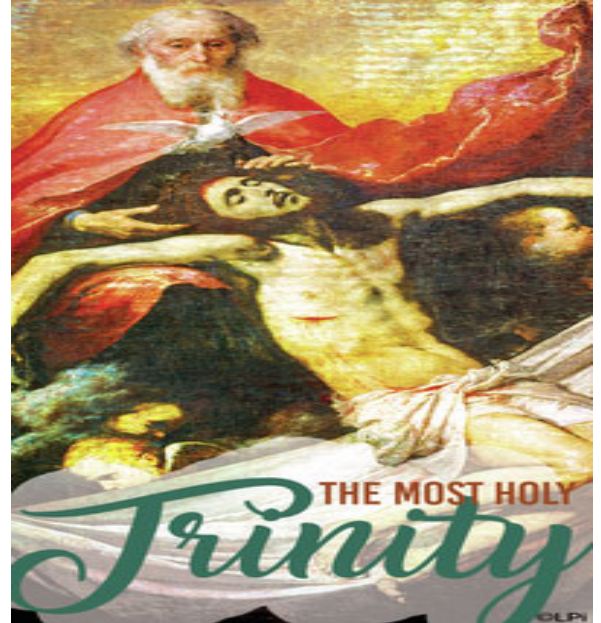
