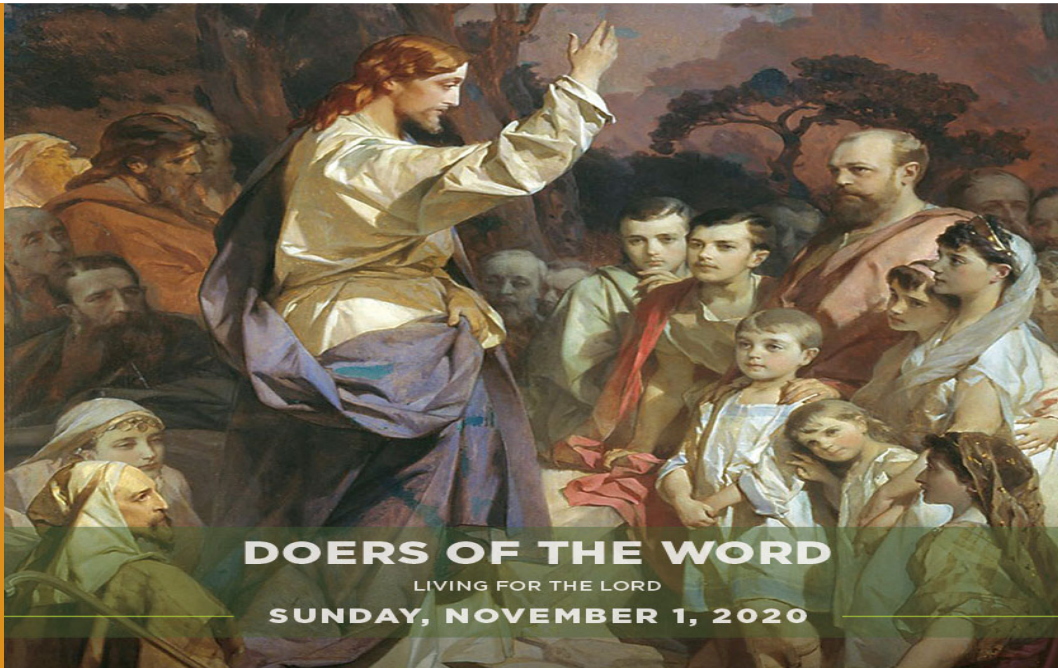

-WEEKLY PRAYER-

LIVE THE LITURGY

Especially with regard to living the Gospel, we are not alone. A great cloud of witnesses journey with us offering us inspiration, wisdom, intercession, and support. We look to them for the example of perseverance we desperately need in order to be faithful, and for what it means to "walk the talk!" The Beatitudes are indeed a blessed vision that people hunger to hear and embrace. But, they also clearly remind us that following Jesus is difficult. Poverty of spirit, meekness, mercy, and peace making are not virtues readily accepted by the world. Pursuing a purity of heart and acknowledging the hunger of our souls require not only a courageous stance, but a single-minded devotion to God. And, after going against the grain of the world and meeting resistance along the way, the true disciple may find themselves persecuted and paying a high price. Look to all the saints for the secret to happiness and the example of fidelity. Their lives speak volumes of how God can use even the weakest and most humble among us in tremendous ways. Saints are not even close to being perfect. They are just ordinary folks like us trying to give honor to God with their lives.

La pobreza de espíritu, la mansedumbre, la misericordia y la construcción de la paz no son virtudes fácilmente aceptadas por el mundo. Perseguir una pureza de corazón y reconocer el hambre de nuestras almas requiere no solo una postura valiente, sino una devoción decidida a Dios. Y, después de ir contra la corriente del mundo y encontrar resistencia en el camino, el verdadero discípulo puede verse perseguido y pagar un alto precio. Mira a todos los santos para el secreto de la felicidad y el ejemplo de la fidelidad. Sus vidas dicen mucho de cómo Dios puede usar incluso a los más débiles y humildes entre nosotros de maneras tremendas. Los santos no están siquiera cerca de ser perfectos. Solo son personas comunes como nosotros tratando de honrar a Dios con sus vidas.

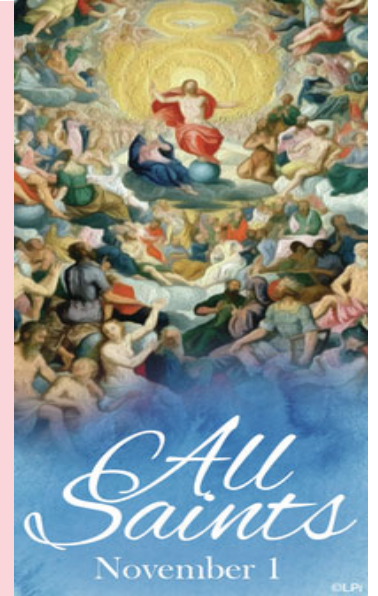

La activista católica Mary “Madre” Jones fue famosa por aconsejar: “Reza por los muertos— y muchísimo por los vivos.” Hizo ambas cosas, especialmente luchando por los derechos de los mineros y contra el trabajo infantil a principios del siglo XX. Llamada la “mujer más peligrosa de América” por su influencia en la clase trabajadora, habló por quienes no tenían su voz, por esta gente que la sociedad no querían escuchar. Madre Jones nunca será una santa en los libros, pero hizo lo que hacen los santos: escuchó atentamente las preocupaciones de su tiempo, y luego fue a dar pelea por las necesidades de los oprimidos. ¿Quién necesita tu voz— y tal vez tus habilidades de boxeo?

Get in the ring

Catholic activist Mary “Mother” Jones famously urged: “Pray for the dead—and fight like hell for the living.” She did both, especially fighting for miner’s rights and against child labor at the turn of the 20th century. Called the “most dangerous woman in America” for her clout with the laboring class, she spoke for those who weren’t heard. Mother Jones won’t ever be a saint on the books, but she did as saints do: listened carefully to the concerns of her times, then went in punching for the needs of the oppressed. Who needs your voice—and maybe your boxing skills?

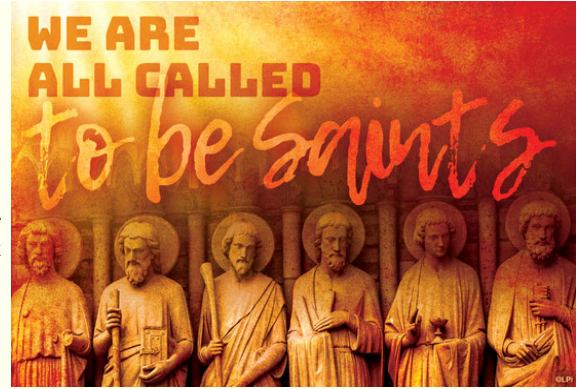

-ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING-

ALL SAINTS

I remember as a child the meticulousness my father would bring to a task. Whether it be tending to a chore in the yard, repairing something, or painting a room, the tiniest of every detail demanded his attention. He had great patience. I benefited greatly by his example and remember these lessons well. We all need examples to follow. It is important to identify folks who excel at simple things and show us how to do things well. There are those among us and those who have gone before us who serve as these models and witnesses. They are ordinary people who in their “extraordinary ordinariness” capture our attention and allow us to see things more clearly.



These are the prophets, martyrs, teachers, witnesses, heralds, and innovators who bring a single-minded devotion to God to even the simplest of tasks they perform. They have an openness to being used and become vessels of Divine justice, mercy, and presence. They call us to the “more” of life and point us to the Gospel in all of its simplicity and splendor. They remind us of the little ones of the Kingdom and the values we all need to cultivate and possess. They are the poor in spirit, the meek, the merciful, and the peacemaker who often are rejected not only by those who have far different agendas but by those you think would welcome them.

All of the saints in heaven and on earth form this cloud of witnesses who journey with us as we make our way through life. They offer us inspiration, wisdom, intercession, and support. They direct us toward true happiness and remind us that we are all called to be saints. All it takes is desire, love, and fidelity. There is much we can learn from the official saints of the church. Their guidance is ever before us and ever with us. But there is also a lot to learn from the unofficial saints of the church. They sit beside us every Sunday, are our neighbors and ordinary people we meet every day. Because of the devotedness of their faith, they remind us to keep going, remain focused, and cultivate purpose and meaning, and give voice to those who have none. The inspiration is all around us.

Pay attention to the details. Do what you do with great love. Know that you are not alone. Believe that you can persevere. Have great faith.

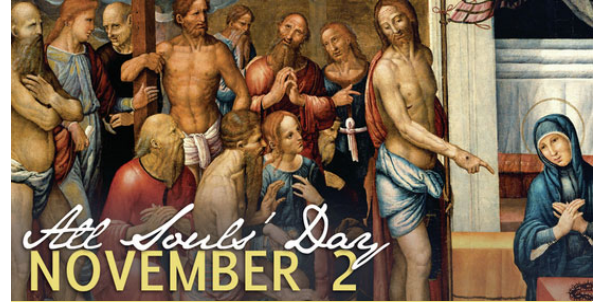
